May 31	The Visitation of the Blessed Virgin Mary	
August 6		The Transfiguration
August 15 <sup>th</sup>	The Assumption of the BVM	
Nov. 1 <sup>st</sup>	All Saints Day	
Nov. 2 <sup>nd</sup>	All Souls Day	
Last Sunday in Ordinary Time	Christ the King – celebration of Jesus as our King, Lord, and messiah	

Solemnity/ Feast	Description
Conversion of St. Paul	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Saul was persecuting the Christians.</li> <li>• He was knocked off his horse and became blind. He heard God say, "Why are you persecuting me?"</li> <li>• He got his sight back and became an evangelist to the Gentiles.</li> </ul>
Presentation of the Lord	
The Chair of St. Peter the Apostle	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Jesus gave Peter the keys</li> <li>• Commemorates Christ choosing Peter as the servant authority of the church</li> <li>• Established St. Peter as the first Pope.</li> </ul>
<i>St. Joseph, husband of Mary</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <i>Celebration of St. Joseph, Mary's husband and Jesus' foster father.</i></li> </ul>
<i>The Annunciation</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <i>Angel Gabriel appears to Mary</i></li> <li>• <i>She has been chosen to be the mother of our Lord, Jesus.</i></li> <li>• <i>She says, "Yes!"</i></li> </ul>
<i>The Visitation of the Blessed Virgin Mary</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <i>Mary visits Elizabeth</i></li> <li>• <i>Both are pregnant</i></li> <li>• <i>"Hail Mary, full of grace. The Lord is with you!"</i></li> </ul>
Transfiguration	
<i>The Solemnity of the Assumption of the BVM</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <i>Mary is assumed into heaven, body and soul</i></li> </ul>
<i>All Saints Day</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <i>Dedicated to the Saints of the church who have attended heaven</i></li> </ul>
<i>All Souls Day</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <i>Holy Day set aside for honoring the dead</i></li> </ul>
<i>Corpus Christi</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <i>Celebration of the Body and Blood of Christ</i></li> </ul>
